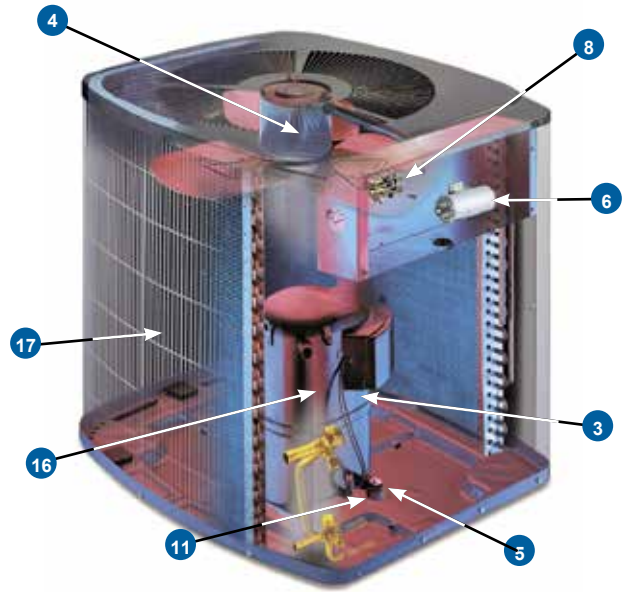
- Condensing Unit

Air Handling Unit

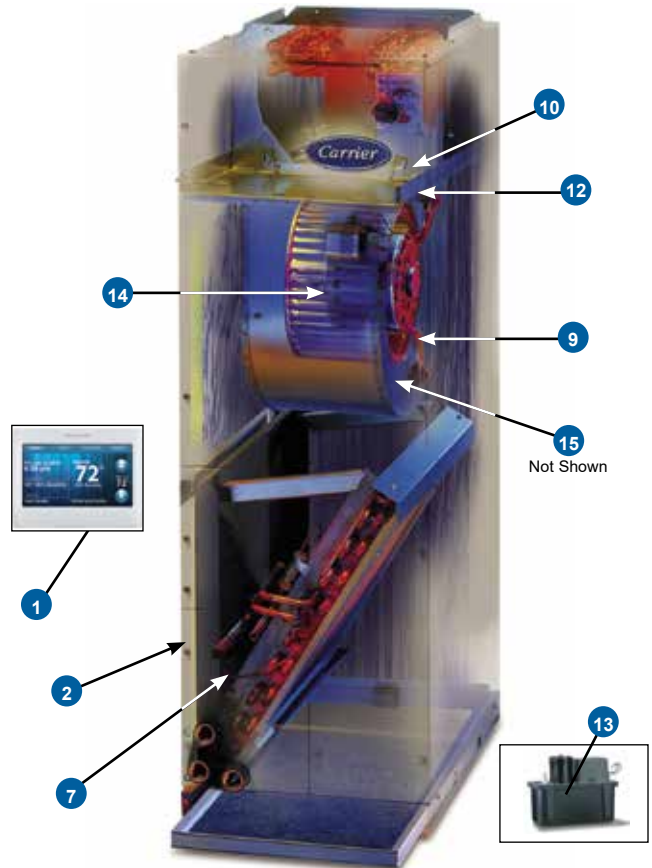
- Check or replace air filters (standard media type)
- Check blower hub fan for dirt build up
- Check & clean heating coil
- Check evaporator coil for dirt build up
- Check condensate drain line and connections
- Check condensate drain pan for corrosion
- Check condensate pump
- Check all drain lines
- Check fan belts for wear
- Check & clean blower hood fan

Parts & Labor Coverage (repair or replacement)
