- Check & clean blower hood fan

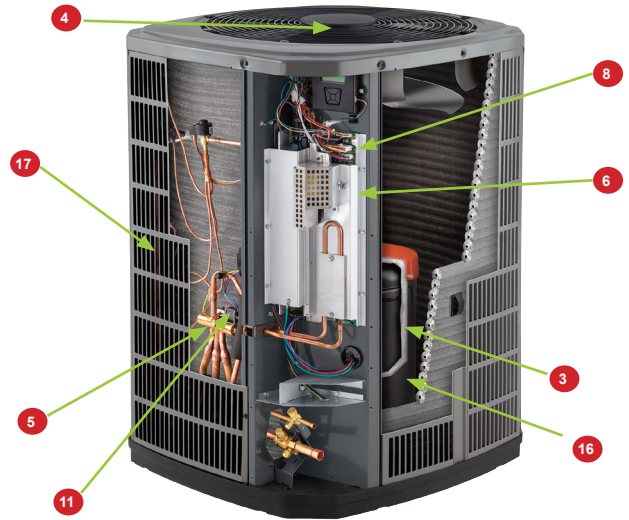

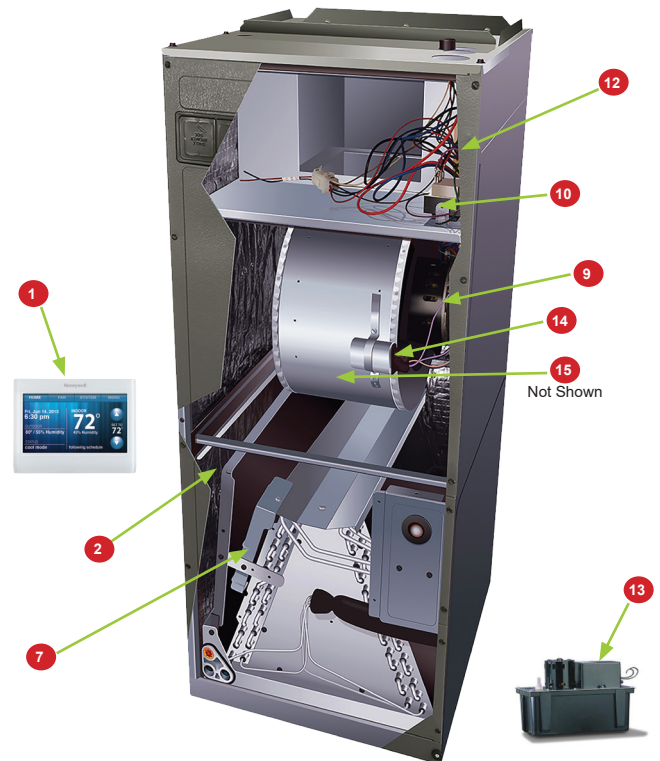
Refrigerants
